# Norm:

Talked to Claude Curley, he is way behind at the moment. Sam is  $4^{th}$  in line to get his water license. Hopefully by the end of the month.

Sam is going to school at the end of May-June. It is a 5 day/4week program. Norm is gone to school from May 20-22 and then he is gone camping May 22-27.

Water salesman coin mechanism broke again. Norm fixed it last fall. Called the company and they sent the coin part for \$100 but we need the whole mechanism. It will be another \$100.

We need some new flags for the power poles. Need about 20 2x3 flags. They are \$26 a piece on carrottop and \$10 a piece on amazon.

Mill St building permit: Norm talked to the owner. They are going to talk to their neighbor about having them sign off on a variance, so they do not have to move the shed.

We should ask the state for some road closure signs from DOT.

Cameras: Library had a potential break-in to their shed. Might be a good idea to get cameras for the Municipal Building. Add an extra layer of security.

There is a small crack on the siding of the garage. A customer of the water salesman backed up a little too far and cracked the siding. It is smaller than a quarter. They are willing to pay for the repair. The consensus was it was too small to worry about. Will address again at the next meeting.

## Old Business:

Changing table is installed, the safety strap was missing. They send one but it does not fit the changing table. Sent more pictures today. Waiting to hear back.

Lilac Festival: there was a meeting last night. There is a lot of interest in the event. Over 50 vendors. Facebook page has over 6K people interested. We need to look for barrels for garbage, porta-pottys and handwashing stations. The garbage can go in the back of the dump truck for the day.

Insurance: 500 people - \$240
